- Is teaching designed to help learners remember content in the long term and to integrate new knowledge into larger concepts?
- Are leaders engaging and constructive in the way they manage staff including their workload?
- Are pupils committed to their learning, do they take pride in their achievements and are they resilient to setbacks?
- Do the large majority of pupils leave your school prepared for the next stage of their education and to succeed in life?

The day will be structured with a mixture of input and theory, activities, group discussions and facilitated reflections. To get the maximum impact from this day it is strongly advised to book for a minimum of two leaders from your school setting. As a result, your leadership team will leave with a clear vision and well-considered actions to make sure your school, staff and pupils are ready for the future.
